



Cancer and Treatment


- ■Intermittent leave

ADHD


- Explain what is going on with the brain

Irritable Bowel Syndrome

- Define Irritable Bowel Syndrome

- Employee was tied to phone at desk
- Intermittent leave for late morning

What is MCS? (cont.)

- Symptoms:
 - Neurological impairments:
 - Headaches, migraines, difficulty thinking, seizures
 - Respiratory involvement:
 - Asthma, reactive airways, sinusitis, balance
 - Muscular difficulties:
 - pain, weakness, fatigue
 - Cardiovascular problems:
 - Arrhythmias, hypertension, hypotension, edema
 - Gastrointestinal complaints:
 - Irritable bowel, reflux



Seizures

- Diagnosed with seizures approximately 2 years ago after having one at work
- Working in call center and may have to take emergency calls
- Side effects from medication prevent her from taking calls
- Change of job duties for 2 hours after taking medications



Concussion/Low Back Strain

- Fell in parking lot at work
- Worker's compensation claim denied
- Not eligible for FMLA Leave as a Reasonable Accommodation provided
- Cognitive & Behavioral Capacities Evaluation Form
- Graduated return to work 4 hours per day for one week
- Modified full-time work hours 2 days per week to allow employee to attend physical therapy
