10:30AM – 12:00PM | Vocational Rehabilitation Services for H-2A Workers: Unique Approaches to Complex Cases by Eloisa Flores and Nicole Dupre, VRCs

The number of temporary agricultural visas issued annually has quadrupled in the last 15 years. According to State Department data, there were over 213,000 H-2A visas issued in 2020. So, what happens when an H-2A worker experiences an industrial injury? How are rehabilitation services provided effectively to workers whose visas expire mid-treatment? The purpose of this presentation will be to identify some of the many challenges to serving injured H-2A workers, as well as to share some unique approaches used by the presenters to overcome these barriers along with our ethical obligations when working with out-of-country clients. Specific topics will include ways to identify, educate and partner with foreign medical providers, how to overcome communication barriers, payment issues, transportation issues, trust and rapport building from a distance, ethics, and much more. Examples will focus largely on services provided to workers from Mexico; however, the barriers, challenges, and techniques discussed are universally applicable.
