## **IARP Continues Rollout of Online Member Services and Benefits**

Over the last few of months, IARP has continued its rollout of new online services for members. Starting in April, IARP introduced IARP Connect, the association's online collaboration area, which 650 members have joined to date. At the same time, IARP also introduced the ability for members and non-members to register and pay for

IARP webinars using an online purchasing process. Now more than 80 percent of all registrations are done online (vs. faxing or mailing a paper registration).



### **IARP Introduces Online Membership Renewal**

The IARP membership renewal process has always been a paper-based process. IARP HQ sends out invoices to members whose membership is about to expire. Over a 90 day period, a member will receive up to four notifications via snail mail with a renewal invoice that members fill out and then mail or fax them back. To help simplify and streamline the member renewal process, IARP now offers online membership renewal. In addition to paper-based mailings, IARP will now notify members that they can renew their membership online. When a member's membership is up for renewal, a member will receive an email that details the online renewal process.

Here is a brief overview:

After logging into the IARP site (www.rehabpro.org), renewing members should click on the Account tab. Then, click on the My Transactions link in the left navigation.


Within the My Transactions area, members will see a list of Open Orders that correspond to the various membership products that are ready for renewal (i.e. primary, section(s) and chapter memberships). Just click the Pay Open Orders button on the right side.

Members then select each Open Order, enter in a discount code ("FSEC-FSEC") to receive their first Section free, and then click on the Next button to go to a final screen where they will enter in their credit card information.

The entire process takes less than a couple minutes to complete.

Members immediately receive a receipt via email.

So if your membership is up for renewal, please consider using this new online process. You will receive detailed instructions via email (when your membership is available for renewal), or if you can't wait, just send an email to <a href="mailto:iarp-hq@tcag.com">iarp-hq@tcag.com</a> and we will send you the instructions.

## CRCC Announces Call to Action Regarding VA

Commission of Rehabilitation Counselor Certification (CRCC) issued the following release on October 20:

## ARCA/CORE/CRCC/NRCA

The issue:

The Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) has issued qualification standards formally recognizing certain licensed professional counselors as mental health specialists within the Veterans Health Administration. The standards are now available online.

Presently, the regulations require licensed professional counselors to have a master's degree in mental health counseling or a related field from a program accredited by the Council on Accreditation of Counseling and Related Educational Programs (CACREP). According to the release, examples of related mental health counseling fields include, but are not limited to addiction counseling; community counseling; gerontology counseling; marital, couple, and family counseling; and marriage and family therapy.

Although this is a positive step forward for the counseling profession, and an important means of increasing the pool of mental health service providers available to meet the large unmet needs of our nation's veterans, the current standards exclude rehabilitation counselors who are also licensed professional counselors but who did not graduate from a CACREP-accredited counseling program. We believe strongly that this narrow definition is not in the best interest of VA consumers - particularly veterans with disabilities. Click here to read entire Call to Action.

#### **Learning Objectives**

Participants will learn about the impact of lack of selfawareness or insight (anosognosia) that often occurs following a traumatic brain injury on life care planning development.
