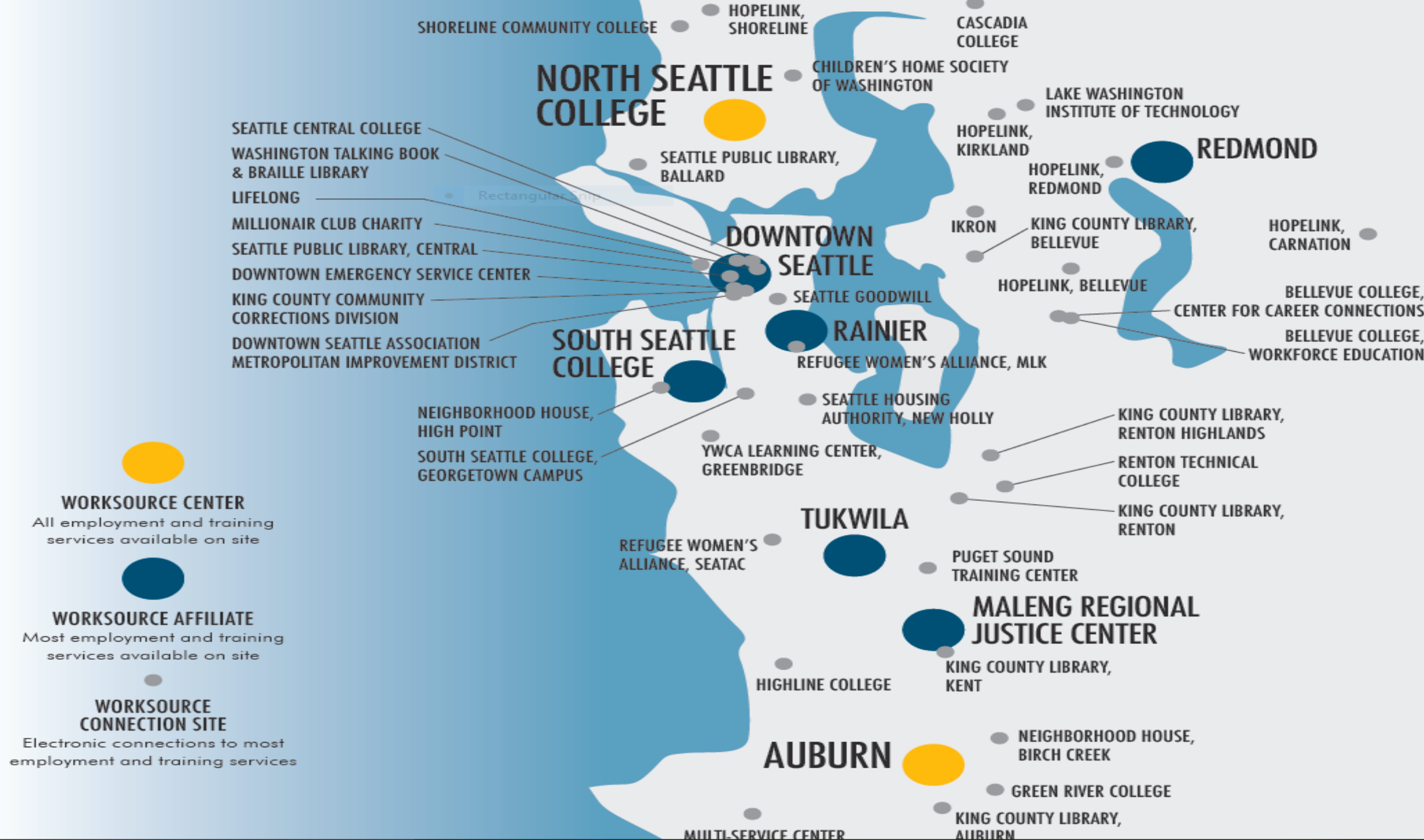

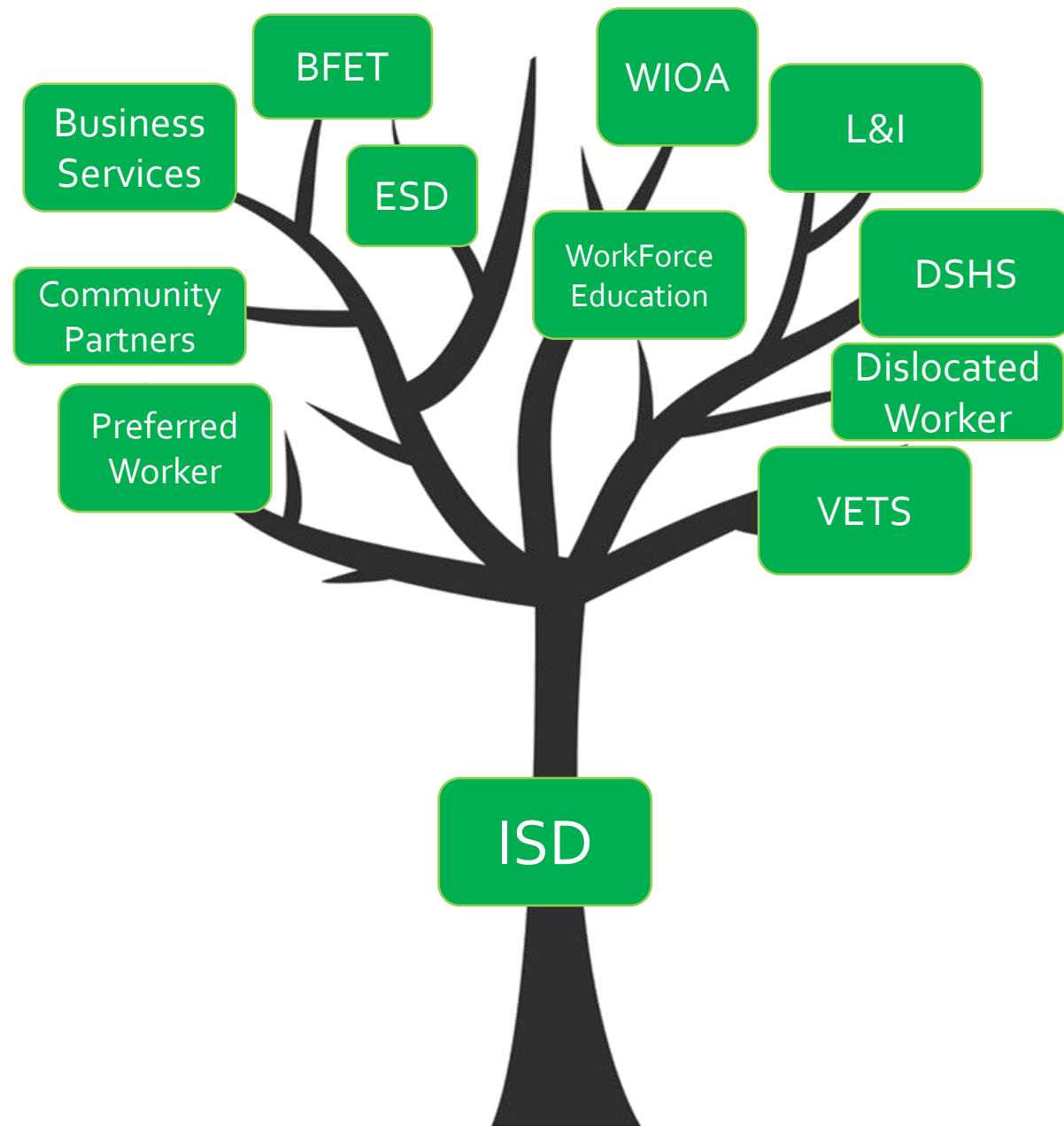

What you can expect with L&I/WorkSource Partnership:

- Voluntary Participation
- Specialized Assistance from vocational rehabilitation professionals
- No fees for services with VSS
- No time limit on services; the claim may be in any status including a closed claim
- Ability to meet with a WorkSource VSS during any phase of vocational services including ERTW, AWA, Plan Development, and Plan Implementation services

Opportunities for initiating a referral or to collaborate with WorkSource VSS: when.....

- Resume Services initiated

- Resume Services completed and submitting

- Resume Coversheet used

- Potentially employable based on transferrable skills

- Retraining potential high

- Interested in training regardless of claim outcome

- Internship needed as part of retraining plan

- Worker released to temporary restrictions but not working

- Preferred Workers

- Option 2 participants

- Anytime during any phase of the vocational process

- Exploring OJT opportunities or creating them

- Employer relationship ended
